of a CRCC Asia intern

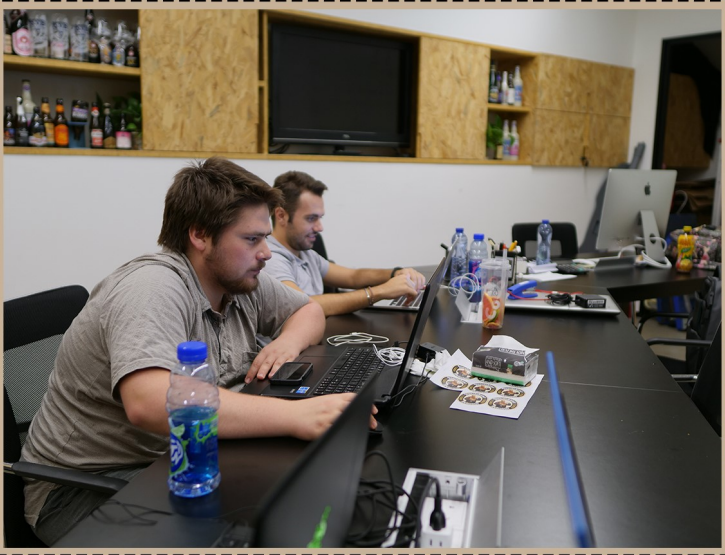


A normal work day for me starts off around 8:30 am with a beautiful view of Shanghai from my apartment window, followed by pop-tarts for breakfast.
